We work alongside parents to ensure that campers are in sessions appropriate to their age and maturity level and we learn as much about campers from parents as possible so we can help make their experience a positive one. However, there are times where a child just isn't ready to function independently in a group of their peers. Campers of any age must be able to follow basic directions with guidance from our staff. For example: staying with the group, wearing safety equipment when necessary (PFD, helmet, harness), using appropriate language, and not causing harm to others or themselves. Campers will be immediately sent home when they become a safety threat to themselves or others without refund.
